



To all Parents/Guardians:

If possible, parents/guardians are advised to give medication at home and on a schedule other than during school hours. If it is necessary that a medication be given during school hours, the following regulations must be followed:

- 1. All medication must be ordered by physician/dentist and permission granted to the school by the parent to give the medication.
2. All medication must be brought to school by parent/guardian in original container with appropriate label intact.
3. Medication can not be put in child's lunch container or taken to the classroom.
4. If medication is not properly labeled, it will not be given.
5. Parent/guardian must sign this form granting the designated school personnel permission to administer medication, according to regulations set herein.
