



RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Residency Requirements for Attendance

California state law provides that public school districts are to serve only children who are residents of the district. A child shall be deemed to have complied with district residency requirements for enrollment in a district school if he/she meets any of the criteria described in District Administrative Regulation 5111.1. Ownership of real property within the district does not in and of itself constitute residency.

Employment within the district boundaries does not constitute residency. The District routinely investigates addresses and declared residency to verify their validity. Please see District Administrative Regulation 5117 for information regarding Interdistrict Attendance Agreements and Permits.
