### **Loma Prieta Community Center Restoration Project**

Construction Schedule:

- North and South entryways to the pedestrian bridge - Complete
- Foundations, under slab utilities, and canopy footings for Buildings A and B - Complete
- Wall framing for Building A - 90% Complete. Roof framing to begin 9/18
- Wall framing for Building B - 75% Complete. Roof framing to begin 9/25
- Interior electrical conduits and plumbing pipe work are in process

- Windows on order and scheduled to be installed beginning 10/4
- Project is on schedule

Financial Summary:

- Projected Project Budget - \$9,511,000
- Expended as of September 12<sup>th</sup> - \$ 2.95 Million
- District Dollars Allocated - Alternate Art Room \$ 192,605

**North Campus Project**

- Abatement of asbestos in the vacant portable buildings is moving forward.
- Rerouting of the PG&E service to bypass the vacant portable buildings will be completed following removal of asbestos.
