- The undefeated 7th-grade girls beat Fisher 59 to 64. Scoring was led by Lindsay Templeton, Katarina Reid, Aiden McGuire, Jasmine Watson, Erika Rohloff, Eleanor Kinsella and Naia Wilcox.

The next meet was at our fast and furious home course – always the best race of the season. All of the Cheetah runners had outstanding performances in the hot, dusty, hilly, rocky tree farm that they are used to running during training. Some highlights:

- Mike Ramsay dominated the 6th-grade boy's race, winning by 24 seconds.
