## Track & Field

The final sport season of the year – track and field – is underway and there are more than 70 Cheetahs and Loma Cougars participating on the team! The first meet was held last week and it was a good experience for the team, with the students faring well against both Monroe and Rolling Hills middle schools. Unfortunately, some of the results weren't recorded correctly, so stay-tuned for more detailed, grade-specific CTE information next week (including hurdle results). Some meet highlights include:

- Carly Hoffner with a 6:24 in the 8<sup>th</sup>-grade girls 1600m run.
- Mike Ramsey finished in 5:42 in the 7<sup>th</sup>-grade boys 1600m run.
- Annie Hoffner finishing first in the girls 800m run, with a time of 2:41.
- Corbin Lane taking third-place in his 800m run, with a time of 3:01.
- Kylie Horn finishing with the third fastest time in the girls' 100m runs, with 14.07.
- Zachary Malstrom ran a 13.91 in the boys 100m dash.
- The 8<sup>th</sup>-grade girls 4x400m relay team won, with 4:42.
- Jeffrey Hamernick placed third in the boys long jump, with a 14' 5" leap.
- Alex Denman placed second in the boys triple jump, with a 25' 6" mark.
- Sam Fulton won the boys shot put, with a throw of 31', and Ian McNamara was next with a 29' 5" throw. Sam also won the boys discus, with a throw of 74'!
