Track & Field

The Cheetahs competed at the League Championships last week and some notable highlights included:

- Alex Denman won both the 7th-grade long jump and triple jump events again, with leaps of 17'2" and 32'8."
- Matthew Lithgow placed third in the 8th-grade boys discus with a throw of 100'9" and also placed fifth in long jump (14'10.5").
- Charles Morris-Caffall placed fourth in the 6th-grade boys discus again with a throw of 55'11.5".
- Michael Vick won the 6th-grade boys 100m dash (12.85s).

Based on their results, Alex, Matthew and Michael qualified to participate in the Santa Clara County Championships that were held on Monday and the boys all represented CTE well!

- Michael Vick finished 2nd-overall in the 6th-grade 100m race.
- Alex Denman was the county champion, winning the 7th-grade boys long jump with a leap of 17'7", which is a school record, and he placed 3rd in the triple jump with a new school record of 34'6.5"!

Based on her performance at the state event, she qualified for the regional championships, which were held this spring in Salt Lake City.
