Congratulations to all of the CTE track and field athletes who competed in the League Championships last week. Here are the highlights of the results:

- Eighth grader, Alex Denman, placed first in the long jump, second in the triple jump and 4th in the 100 meter race with a time of 12.40 and all three of these efforts resulted in three more school records for Alex!
- Rachel Stephens was 4th in the seventh-grade discus with a throw of 58'6".
- Seventh graders Claire Galbo and Matthew Gladney placed 6th in their hurdle races and Matthew was 9th in the boys triple jump.
- Alta Garvey was 7th in the sixth grade girls shot put.
- Katherine Wilcox was 7th in the sixth grade girls long jump.
- Carrick Stevens was 8th in the sixth grade boys 800 meter race.
- Nick Buller was 8th in the sixth grade boys 100 meter race.
- Theo Lohrer was 9th in the boys eighth grade high jump.



Based on their performances at league finals, Alex and Rachel qualified to compete in the County Championships, May 21, where Alex had another stellar competition. Alex finished in 4th-place in the county for the 100 meter race, 3rd in the long jump with another school record of 18'2" and won first place in the triple jump with yet another school record, 38'5.5"!
