

Classroom Expectations

General Behavior Expectations

1. **** KEYS TO SUCCESS!! Be prepared. Listen intently. Always participate.
2. Clean up after yourself.
3. Raise your hand to speak.
4. Use voices only audible to your teammates. In other words, NO shouting across the room to peers or within your table groups.
5. No put-downs! Refrain from negative comments or profanity.
6. No hats or hoods; we want to see you!
7. No eating or gum chewing.
8. Electronic devices are not to be seen or heard (unless directed by Mrs. Siegrist)
9. Do not do work for other classes unless given permission to do so.
10. I dismiss you, not the bell. So, when the bell rings, do not leave your seat until I dismiss you.

Individual & Group Work Expectations

- TRYING- improvement counts
- ASKING- requesting help or clarification from teammates
- HELPING- teammates, classmates and the teacher
- COURTESY- listening to me and your teammates; requests; praises; encouragement, no put downs
- FILLING YOUR ROLE- see job descriptions for specific project

Consequences

If inappropriate behavior is occurring:

1st offense- your warning is a post-it on your table.

2nd offense- you will write down the problem on the post-it and meet with me at lunch.

3rd strike and you go to Mr. Arias' room and report to him. You will be written up on the behavior roll.

Certain offenses may result in automatic detentions:

- Marking on or tampering with anyone else's computer, property or project
- Throwing an object in the classroom or another dangerous behaviors to self or others
- Being disrespectful
